The Chairman called the meeting to order at 7:12 PM

- I. Minutes of the March 2014 meeting were reviewed and approved
- II. Invoices: Hicks Logging presented a invoice for approval regarding bridge replacement on the Pond of Safety Road for \$2,911.24
- III. The parking area project at the end of Randolph Hill Road has been put out for bid with three local construction firms. Bids are Due April 11 at noon and the winner must have the project done by mid June. A special meeting will be held that day at the Randolph Town Hall to review the three proposals and select the winner.
- IV. Doug Mayer followed up with Nikki Pizzo to confirm that the new trail could be ready for the first Saturday in August for the Annual Forest Tour. He confirmed that she assured him that timeframe would be acceptable.
- V. A new trail to the Crystal Mine was discussed with the hopes of including this project in the current budget. Doug Mayer will talk to Carl Demrow, a trails consultant about what possible routes would work. The RMC would be consulted for actual trail construction.
