She suggested that a title search be done to see if any elements in the deeds would offer any clues to important details. She also will search through some historic town documents for any references that would be important to note. This work would be done prior to any decision to demolish the house. A report proposal should be available for the March meeting. If the proposal is approved the finished report would be available for the May meeting.
- III. John Scarinza addressed mentioned that the trailhead parking on the top of Randolph Hill Road project could be reviewed at the next meeting to prepare for a Spring 2014 construction process. Finalized plans had been sent, but not received by this meeting.
